Musical Guest Bob Bennett

This morning we welcome Bob Bennett with us after he was part of the Calvin Crest Men's Retreat. Bob's "Matters of the Heart" album was named Contemporary Christian Music Magazine's 1982 "Album of the Year", and his songs are an important legacy of the Jesus Movement of the 1970s and '80s, but still timeless and relevant. He has recorded 11 albums with numerous Christian artists and performed on tour with Amy Grant, Micheal Card and many others, and recently was recording new music in Canada for an upcoming release.

On his website, Bob says, "I think that accomplishing some sort of ministry by playing music is a completely faulty, frail method that God still manages to use. My primary goal is to communicate truthfully with people. If I can communicate truthfully the life of the Spirit and the always-accompanying struggle along the way, then ministry happens as a natural result of that. If something deep and profound happens, I'm as amazed and grateful as anyone else!"
